

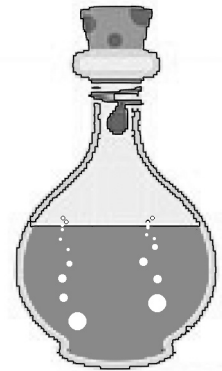
Making Potions
