

# COLOUR

## Colour Memory Game

*Small-group Experience*

### Materials

(for each group)

- sugar paper:
  - several shades of every colour in 50 mm strips;
  - in 100 mm squares in matching colours
- plastic container



## Colour Memory Game

This activity reinforces colour memory and expands pupils' colour awareness.

### Hint

*This game becomes even more challenging if duplicate paint chips from the paint store are used in place of sugar paper strips and squares.*

### Step by Step

1. Write numbers on each matching sugar paper pair – strip and square.
2. Put the strips in the container. Lay the squares, numbers facing down, in random order on a table.
3. Put a chair in front of the table but facing away from the table.
4. One pupil sits in the chair and picks a coloured strip from the container. The pupil reads the number aloud and studies the colour for a few seconds before replacing the strip.
5. The pupil turns around and finds the matching colour square on the table. The pupil reads the number to verify that it is the correct match.
