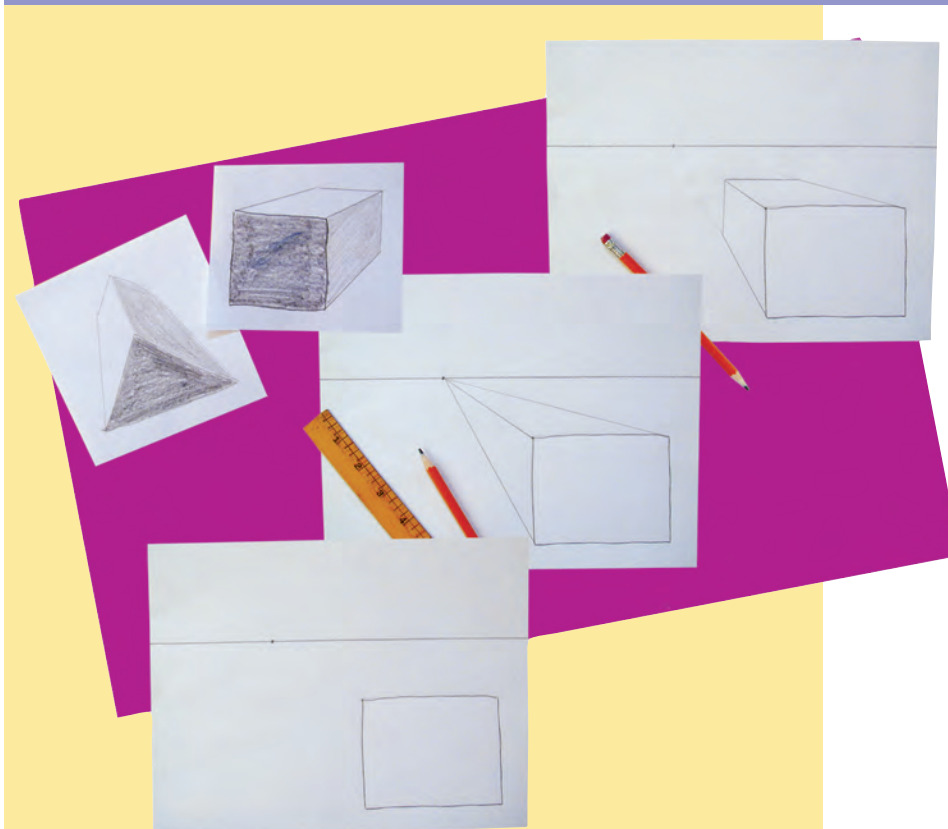


### Materials

(for each pupil)

- A4 (210 x 297 mm) sheet of drawing paper
- ruler
- pencil
- eraser



### Step by Step

1. Pupils trace the horizon line parallel to the top and bottom of the paper.
2. Pupils place a dot on the horizon line. This is the **vanishing point**.
3. Pupils draw a shape with corners anywhere on the paper.
4. Pupils use the ruler to connect the corners of the shape to the vanishing point. If the line would have to go across the shape, it is not drawn.
5. Pupils draw the back side of the shape parallel to the front of the shape.
6. Erase the lines beyond the shape that connect to the vanishing point.
7. Encourage pupils to shade their shapes in different values of colour.

## Perspective, One-point!

Perspective is a tool artists use to create space in their artwork. This time pupils will experiment with one-point perspective.
