

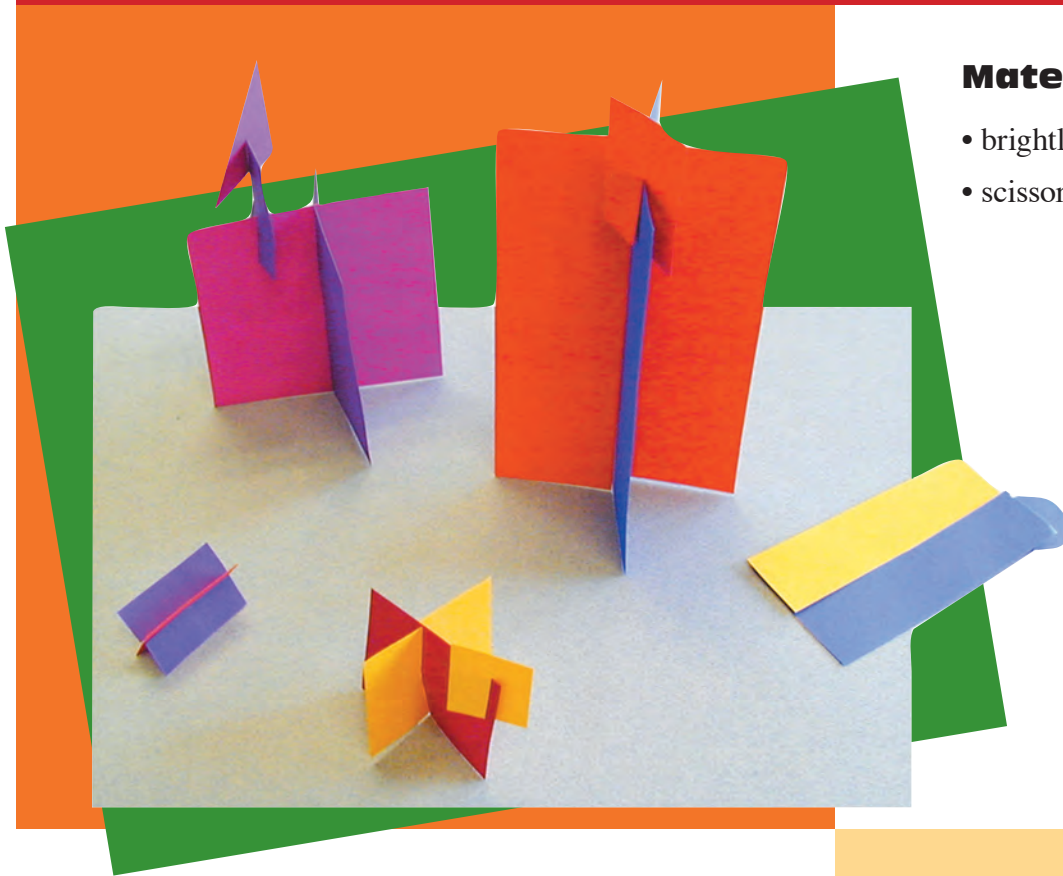

Stand 'Em Up!

Individual Experience

Materials

- brightly coloured sugar paper
- scissors



Step by Step

1. Pupils cut two small identical squares or rectangles from sugar paper. Shapes should not be larger than 13 cm tall.
2. Pupils hold the two papers together and cut a slit halfway up.
3. Reversing one of the shapes, pupils slip one shape over the other to create a three-dimensional form.
4. Repeat, making several forms in different sizes and colours.

Stand 'Em Up!

Pupils combine pairs of two-dimensional shapes into three-dimensional forms.
