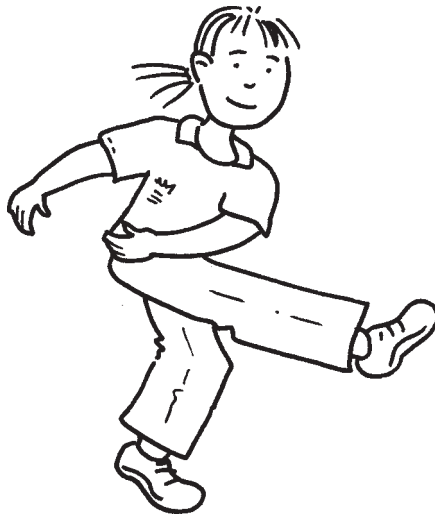


60. Throw and mime

- ◆ As a variation on activity 59, you could attach images of hobbies or classroom commands to the die.
- ◆ Ask the children to throw the die in the box, then mime the activity. The other children should be encouraged to guess in the target language what the activity is.



- ◆ Alternatively you could ask the child to give an instruction to the rest of the class to do a particular action according to the image on the die.
- ◆ Using images of famous personalities or cartoon characters always causes great hilarity especially if you include characters considered to be too young for their 'mature' years.
- ◆ Once again ask the children to throw the sponge die and then act out the character on the die so that the others have to guess who it is.
- ◆ For more able children, there is an opportunity here to practise asking questions.
